³ In other words, you are stuck with me again; you are welcome.



Victor K. Farr, a scion of an ASHRAE family, and former Vice President of Parts supplies at Refrigeration Sales, died July 27, 2016 at age 73 from a lengthy illness. His father was Warren W. Farr, Sr., the founding president of the Cleveland Chapter of the American Society of Refrigerating Engineers in 1941-42. (ASRE and ASHVE combined to form ASHRAE in 1959.) Vic's brother is Warren W. ("Hap") Farr, Jr., ASHRAE Chapter president in 1970-71. We extend our sympathy to Hap. Vic is survived by his wife, four children, ten grandchildren, and a former wife. Funeral services were held on Wednesday, August 3, 2016 at the Ferfolia Funeral Home in Sagamore Hills.

REMEMBERING A PROMINENT PERSON IN OUR INDUSTRY

Donald W. Stenzel was a structural engineer who worked with many of our members during his forty-year tenure with the Barber & Hoffman office, until he retired as President at that firm. Don died at age 92 on Sunday, July 17, 2016. His wife Loie had died earlier, but he is survived by two sons, two daughters, five grandchildren and eleven greatgrandchildren. Don had flown 33 missions as a B-24 bombardier in World War II, including the D-Day invasion, and received the Distinguished Flying Cross (the second-highest award in the U.S. Army Air Corps). He went on to graduate as an engineer from Fenn College, and also served as the ASCE chapter President. His memorial service was held on Saturday morning, July 23, 2016, at John Knox Presbyterian Church in North Olmsted.
